Jack Canfield Memorial Race

13 October 2008 Atlantic Motorsport Park

A three hour endurance race for sedans organized by Atlantic Sports Car Club will be held on Monday, October 13 at Atlantic Motorsport Park. The race will be called the "Jack Canfield Memorial Race" in memory of the life and contributions to motorsport of Jack Canfield. In honour of his life and contributions, Atlantic Motorsport Park, ARRCA, MRT and BAC have agreed to forgo payments for this event. In addition, Kartbahn has agreed to pay for the liability insurance for this event. James Whitman and Lawrencetown Motors has offered to provide an ostentatious trophy for the winning team. Other awards may be provided as well. A pot luck barbeque will be held at lunch time for all the spectators, volunteers, entrants, crews and family to enjoy. Please bring some food to share.

The following rules will be used:

- 1. Sedans will be classed in accordance with current ARMS rules for circuit racing.
- 2. All rules currently in use by ARMS will be used.
- 3. Cars must meet the requirement of a race prepared vehicle and if they have not yet been scrutineered this year, must be prior to entering pit lane and the track. A scrutineer will be available at the track during practice.
- 4. All participants must be members in good standing of ASCC, BAC, MMSC, FMC, NBSCC, AFRA or another approved ASN Canada/FIA club.
- 5. All drivers must have a current race license. This license shall be an ARMS regional race license, an SCCA race license or any other recognized FIA license.
- 6. "Retired" drivers who have previously held a race license but have not participated in a racing event in recent years, may apply in advance for an ASCC Club race license. A description of previous racing experience and a physical heath examination in accordance with the form contained on the ASN Canada/FIA website will be required to be submitted in advance of the event for approval by the organizers.
- 7. The race shall be 3 hours long with the car recording the most laps after 3 hours of racing (including red flag time) being declared the winner.
- 8. A minimum of one standard 5 minute pit stop will be required of each car.
- 9. Pit stops to change driver or perform maintenance on the car other than refueling, will not be timed but must be done in a safe manner.
- 10. Refueling stops will be required to be a minimum of 5 minutes plus the previous lap time plus 10 seconds transition time. The driver must be out of the car and the car turned off before any refueling begins. The refueler must be protected by a full nomex suit, balaclava, socks and shoes and full coverage helmet. A crew member must be standing by with a fully charged ABC fire extinguisher ready in case of emergency. Only after the refueling is complete may the driver reenter the car.

- 11. Speed on the pit lane will be restricted to 50kph and monitored. Speed in excess of the maximum will be penalized by a one lap penalty.
- 12. Leaving the pits after a refueling stop or the required pit stop before the time allotment will be penalized by lap penalties depending upon the number of seconds the car is early leaving the pits.
- 13. Gridding will be by car class with GT1 cars gridding at the front, followed by GT2, GT3 and so on. Grid positions within each class will be by draw prior to the race.

Registration:

- 1. Each car taking part will be required to register with the organizing club in advance of the race.
- 2. The cost for each car registering prior to October 1 will be \$100. Cars registering after October 1st and up to 10:00 October 13 will be required to pay \$200.
- 3. All cheques shall be payable to Atlantic Sports Car Club.
- 4. The income from registrations shall be used to build new marshal stands at AMP.
